






- Represents the leading providers of healthcare IT in Germany

 - Inform the public about the market







RECENT GERMAN E-HEALTH LEGISLATION




- ► IT-Security Act 2014
 - Overall increased coordination and reporting requirements (similar to NIS-Directive)
 - Critical infrastructures in healthcare; mostly hospitals (30.000 cases p.a.)
 - bvitg involved in defining security standard for the healthcare sector (2018)
- eHealth Act 2015
 - Focus on *Telematics Infrastructure* and attached services
 - Interoperability Registry (June 2017)
 - ► Electronic Patient Record (2018)

TELEMATICS INFRASTRUCTURE



- Test roll-out:Q3 2016
- Federal roll-out: Q3 2017
- First applications:
 Q1 2018




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EUROPEAN REGULATION



- ► General Data Protection Regulation (EU GDPR)
 - New requirements applicable in May 2018
 - Germany first EU member to adjust national law to fit the requirements of the EU GDPR (expected before fall 2017)
- Medical Device Regulation (MDR)
 - National Implementation Process initiated (bvitg an advisor to the process)
 - Art. 11 MDR!
