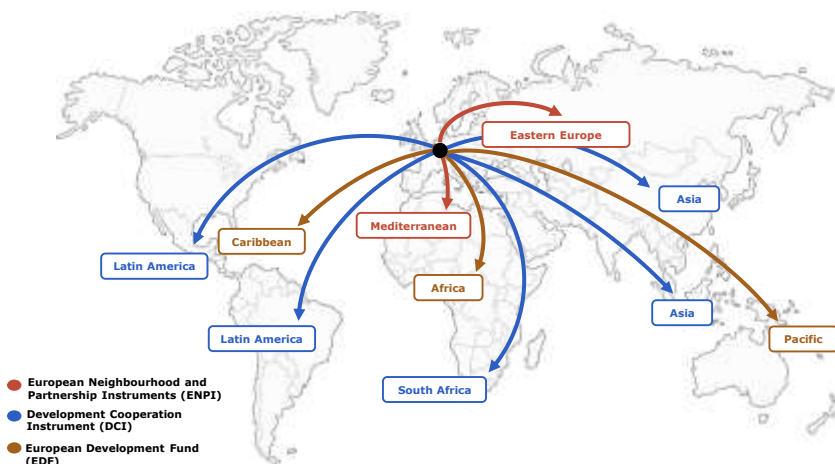

EU's development cooperation with Latin America and the Caribbean

Programmable aid

- ✓ Bilateral cooperation: fields are defined jointly by the government of a third country and the EU
- ✓ Regional cooperation: aspects e.g. security, environmental sustainability and vulnerability, inequality, inclusive and sustainable growth are addressed at continental level

Non - Programmable aid

- ✓ Thematic cooperation: to tackle worldwide and universal issues e.g. human rights, environment, civil society, food security and migration and asylum
- ✓ Others: ECHO, Instrument for Stability, Partnership Instrument



EU Communication on Agenda for Change: impact on Latin America

Principles:

- ✓ Concentration and graduation

Focus on results:

- ✓ more effective aid: joint programming and a common results framework with EU MS
- ✓ innovative ways of financing development, such as blending grants and loans
- ✓ greater alignment of internal and external policies

Impact on Latin America: only 6 countries with bilateral envelopes + 3 in phasing out (17 countries in 2007-2013), but enhanced regional allocation





EU's development cooperation with Latin America and the Caribbean 2014-2020

Region	Financial instrument	Indicative allocations 2014-2020 (bilateral + regional)
Latin America	DCI	2.4 billion €
Caribbean	EDF + DCI (Cuba)	1 billion €

Main objectives:

Poverty eradication

Development, especially social cohesion and the fight against inequalities, good governance and democracy, sustainable development and regional integration



Food security, agriculture and rural development as a priority in bilateral allocations 2014-2020

Honduras - 100 M €
Guatemala - 80 M €
Nicaragua - 78 M €

Haiti - 90 - 100 M €
Cuba - 21 M €
Suriname - 13 M €





Other related sectors in bilateral allocations 2014-2020

Latin America

El Salvador: private sector development (61 M)

Paraguay: private sector development & trade policy (20 M)

Nicaragua: climate change (50 M)

Guatemala: competitiveness (65 M)

Bolivia: fight against drugs (alternative development) (86 M)

Colombia, Ecuador and Peru: sustainable trade (74 M)

Caribbean:

Dominican Republic: inclusive productive development (32M)

St. Lucia: employment via private sector development (5.3M)

Trinidad&Tobago: competitive and innovative economy (8M)



Major programmes on food security, agriculture and rural development 2014-2015

2014:

Honduras: Food security in the Dry Corridor (30M €)

Guatemala: Family agriculture (21.1M €)

2015:

Central America: Fight against coffee rust (15M)

Honduras, Bolivia, Dominican Republic, St. Lucia - under preparation





Other related sectors in regional allocations 2014-2020

Latin America:

- *Inclusive and Sustainable Economic Growth (215 M)*
- *Environmental Sustainability and Vulnerability (300 M)*

Central America sub-regional:

- *Regional economic integration (40 M)*
- *Climate Change (35 M)*

Caribbean:

- *Regional economic cooperation & integration (102 M)*
- *Climate Change (61.5 M)*



How do we work?

Bilateral programmes:

- *Project approach*
- *Budget support*
- *Via EU development agencies, international organisations*

Regional programmes:

- *Blending (LAIF, CIF)*
- *Calls for proposal*





Examples

Central America: Fight against Coffee Rust

Coverage: 6 Central American countries + Dominican Republic (budget – 15 million €)

Expected results:

- Regional warning system
- Technological coffee production models
- Policy development

Impact:

- 330 000 producer families with improved livelihoods
- Income increase by 20%
- Leaf rust control adopted by 70% of farmers

Implementing body:

- Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture (IICA)

Examples

AL-INVEST 5.0: Inclusive Growth for Social Cohesion in Latin America Latina

It provides grants to European and Latin American

(i) Business intermediary organisations representing Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises. This includes chambers of commerce, sector-specific trade, industrial and professional associations, cooperatives, regulatory bodies and agencies promoting trade, investment and commercial activities as well as sector-based agencies concerned with working with SMEs

..or

(ii) Public agencies (typically boards of investment, trade promotion agencies etc.) at local, national and regional level
