GHANA CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT TO STANDARDS (G-CAP)

DEFERMENT OF IMPLEMENTATION DATE

The implementation date of 1st October 2014 of the Ghana Conformity Assessment Programme (G-CAP) has been deferred by the Ghana Standards Authority as recommended by the Ministry of Trade and Industry. This is to allow further engagement of all stakeholders in discussions and sensitisation programmes to ensure that issues about the G-CAP are clearly explained and understood.

The G-CAP is a conformity assessment process used to verify that imported products are in conformity with the requirements of applicable standards, technical regulations and applicable laws before exporting to a destination country. This process is aimed at ensuring that products imported into the Ghanaian market are of the required quality to protect public health, safety and the environment.
