ElectriFI – Investment scope

- <u>Scope</u>: investments private companies access to energy space renewable energy sources and technologies financially sustainable scalable
- <u>Indicators</u>: connections capacity rural/underserved areas
- Role: early stage innovative high risk additional catalyst
- Geographical scope:
 - ➤ Global facility : emerging countries globally and with specific attention to sub-Saharan African countries
 - Dedicated country windows anticipated
- <u>Instruments</u>: flexible all products (equity, quasi equity, junior debt, senior debt, etc.)
 no grants
- Size: min. EUR 0.5 M max. EUR 10 M
- <u>Currency</u>: LCY when possible USD/EUR
- <u>Dealflow sourcing</u>: organised 2 CFP 450 applications received co-investments with
 DFI exploring additional deal flow sourcing mechanisms











Investment#1: Micro-grids with Solar PV & battery storage

- Country: Haiti
- Targeted capacity: 3.5 MW
- **ElectriFl investment:** USD 2.5 M quasi equity
- Business model: Building, owning and operating of a Minigrid:
 - Connecting: 27'000 households (136'000 people) with offtaker agreements signed with municipalities
 - Innovative: using a proprietary energy metering technology
 - Providing scale: interconnectivity of micro-grids will permit an installed capacity of 3.5 MW
- **Technology:** Solar PV with battery storage and diesel genset
- Project stage: Start Up Mini-grids are running in 1 municipality expansion to 5 towns is being targeted - ElectriFI first professional investor after angel investors
- Impact objectives:
 - Targeted 27'000 connections (136'000 people) in 5 towns and connected through transmission line
 - Anticipated leverage of 5.8 (total project cost of USD 14 M vs. ElectriFI investment of USD 2.5 M)
