- Total UK exports to Germany amounted to £47.4 billion in the four quarters to the end of Q3 2021.
- Germany is the UKs second largest trading partner, second largest export market and second largest for imports.
- The UK is host to a number of Germany's most significant investors, some of which have been present for over a century (e.g. Siemens, BMW).






