<ul> <li>★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★</li> <li>✓ <u>Direct centralised</u>: Programme management is conducted by the European Commission (Brussels of Delegations)</li> </ul>
✓ <u>Indirect centralised</u> : Transfer of responsibility from the EC to a national body, in most cases, the development agency (or equivalent) of an EU Member State
✓ <u>Decentralised</u> : Transfer of responsibility from the EC to the authorities of the beneficiary countries
<ul> <li>✓ <u>Joint</u>: Transfer of responsibility from the EC to an International Organisation (UN, Mercosur, UEMOA, etc.)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>✓ <u>Shared</u>: Transfer of responsibility to EU Member States (under ENPI/IPA CBC programmes)</li> </ul>



















