- Projects are presented by a Lead Finance Institution...

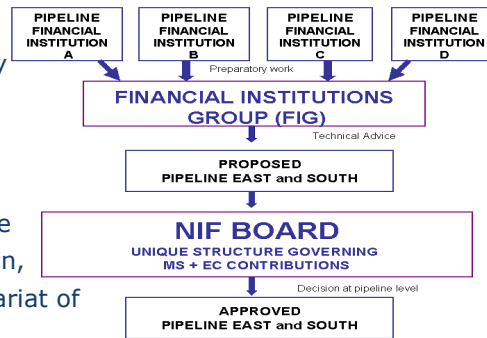
- ... to the **Finance**

### **Institution Group (FIG)**

where they are technically discussed -> and submitted for approval to the NIF **Board**

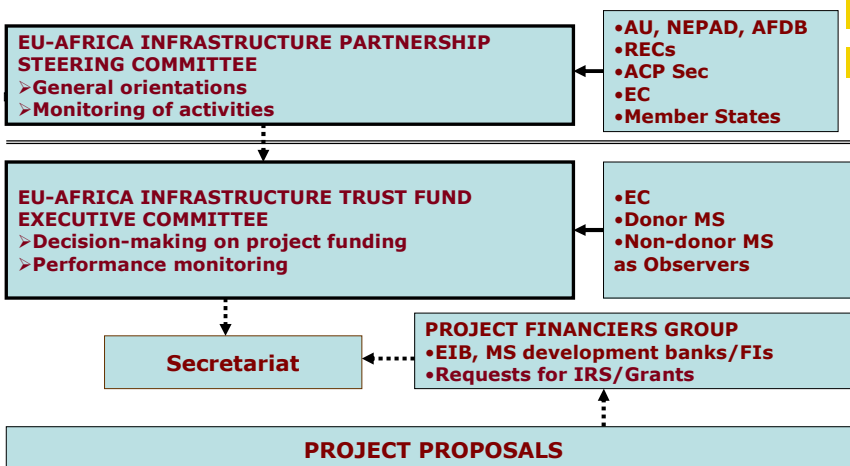
- The FIG and the Board are chaired by the Commission, which also acts as Secretariat of the Investment Facilities

- NIF spending so far: 170 M€ (EC funding); 7.4 bn € (total projects); share of transport projects = 35%

ITF spending so far: 100 M€ (EC funding); 1.3 bn € (total projects); share of transport projects = 43%
